Oh Pray Tell encourages listeners to **watch, listen, and share** this video with those who might find strength in its message.

Originally written for their children, "**The Rain It Falls**" is a deeply personal work. Against a backdrop of very uncertain times and devastating global events, this song is a humble offering of validation - "it's ok to feel just how you feel." The trio uses this particular song as medicine to help them feel a sense of grounding and embodiment and they wish to offer it up to whomever else it may resonate.

"This song isn't about finding an easy answer or pretending everything is okay," says member Sally Titasey. "But we're acknowledging a hard reality, we're acknowledging our bodies and our nervous systems, so we can find it in ourselves to take the next step. We try to remember that life continues to emerge, even in the hardest times."
